Sir /Madam,

National Education Policy 2020 outlines the vision to place emphasis on the promotion of Indian languages. Accordingly, Bhasha Sangam is an initiative of Department of School Education and Literacy, Ministry of Education under Ek Bharat Shreshtra Bharat programme with the objective of familiarizing every child with simple sentences in all the 22 languages under Schedule VIII of the Constitution of India, taking up at least one language on each working day.

The Hon'ble Minister of Education has launched the booklets based on 100 sentences and a Bhasha Sangam Mobile App to facilitate the students. The Bhasha Sangam booklets are in line with NEP provisions and presented in such a way that children in school will be able to read in the Indian language, in Devanagari script, in roman script and translations into Hindi and English and in audio and video form with Indian Sign Language

All the School Heads are requested to disseminate the above information amongst all the students, teachers and parents to enhance their multilingual skills through this Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat initiative and also requested to:

- a) Encourage the students to learn and use these sentences in their daily life
- b) Encourage teachers to learn these languages to set examples to their students
- c) Write /exhibit one sentence a day on a common board/notice board for students to learn
- d) Encourage students to do role plays around these sentences by using the same language or more than one language.
- e) Encourage students to write letters to schools in partner states with the help of these sentences.
- f) Hold quiz competitions around these sentences to encourage better retention by adding a fun factor to learning.
- g) Encourage teachers and students to develop similar sentences in local dialects/home languages spoken by them and present before their classes.
- h) Upload these booklets on the school's website.
