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### Press Release

It is hereby notified that the system for the conduct, supervision, and online uploading of Practical Examinations for Class X and Class XII under the Central Board of Open Schooling & Examination (CBOSE) for the Examination Session 2021–22 has been made functional with immediate effect. All learners, study centres, and examination functionaries are informed that the Practical Examination process shall now be organised strictly in accordance with the guidelines, schedule, and instructions issued by the Board from time to time. The centres shall ensure that the laboratories, equipment, and requisite records are maintained in readiness before the commencement of the examination.

For the learners of the current academic session (**Stream 1 – Block 1, 2022**), the Practical Examinations shall be conducted at their respective study centres on the dates allotted and notified separately. Learners are required to report to the centre with their Practical Files/Project Work and valid identity documents as prescribed. Study centres must verify the identity of each learner, maintain attendance records, and conduct the practical assessment in the presence of authorised examiners. After completion of the examinations, the centres shall upload the awarded marks through the CBOSE Student Dashboard within the stipulated time.

From the next examination session (**Stream 1 – Block 2, 2022**), it shall be mandatory for all affiliated study centres to submit, enter, and upload the Practical Marks online only through the official portal of the Board. No offline submission, manual entries, or physical documents shall be entertained. Centres must ensure proper training of staff, availability of internet and systems, and strict compliance with the revised protocol established by the Board. Any deviation, delay, or failure in uploading marks shall be treated as non-compliance and may attract action as per examination regulations.
