**SUBJECT: INAUGURATION OF THE JUNE 2025 BOARD EXAMINATION & NEXT-GEN
EXAMINATION GOVERNANCE SYSTEM (NEG-S 2025)**

Madam/Sir,

The Central Board of Open Schooling & Examination (CBOSE) conducted the *National Result Analytics & Digital Credentials Summit 2025* to announce the results of the June 2025 Board Examination and unveil the next generation of digital academic credentials. This national-level event marked a defining moment in the evolution of open schooling, bringing together institutional leaders, examination coordinators, digital certification experts, policymakers, academic researchers and lakhs of learners who participated virtually from across India. The summit represented not only the culmination of the June 2025 assessment cycle but also the beginning of a new era of digital academic transparency, automated evaluation governance and global recognition of CBOSE credentials.

The ceremony opened with a comprehensive address by the Controller of Examinations, who provided an overview of the June 2025 exam cycle. He emphasized that this year witnessed the highest candidate participation ever recorded under CBOSE, reflecting the growing trust in open schooling as a formal and respected educational pathway. He highlighted that learners came from remarkably diverse socio-economic contexts—working professionals, homemakers, adult learners restarting their education, candidates preparing for competitive exams, skill-based students integrating academics into their vocational progression, and those from remote geographies where formal schooling structures are limited. He noted that open schooling is now a national movement of educational inclusion, and the results of 2025 reflect the perseverance and determination of these learners more than anything else.

The summit then transitioned into the official release of the *June 2025 Examination Results*. Instead of merely announcing pass percentages, CBOSE presented an extensive data-driven *National Result Analytics Report 2025*. This report detailed performance-classification across subjects, regional learning patterns, digital learning engagement

artificial intelligence-powered evaluation systems introduced this year. Officials highlighted how data has become an essential tool for understanding learner behaviour, improving curriculum design, and enhancing the support ecosystem for learners who prepare independently.

One of the most transformative announcements of the summit was the introduction of the *CBOSE Global Digital Academic Credential (GDAC 2025)*. This advanced credentialing system uses blockchain-enabled security, encrypted QR validation, international credential mapping standards and tamper-proof digital signatures to create certificates that can be authenticated anywhere in the world. The GDAC 2025 system ensures that employers, universities, foreign credential evaluators and government departments can instantly verify a student's academic record without the need for physical verification or paperwork. Officials explained that GDAC 2025 marks the beginning of a globally aligned credentialing structure for open schooling, ensuring that students can pursue opportunities both within India and internationally.

The summit also addressed the new *Automated Evaluation Governance Pipeline (AEGP 2025)* introduced during the June cycle. This digital evaluation architecture enabled faster script processing, uniform rubric-based marking, automated discrepancy detection, and centralized audit trails. Experts from the evaluation division explained that AEGP 2025 drastically reduced result processing time while enhancing the accuracy and fairness of evaluation. For open schooling learners—many of whom depend on timely results for employment verification, higher education admissions or skill programme enrolment—this acceleration has been particularly beneficial.

Participants engaged in a national live interaction session where learners voiced questions regarding rechecking procedures, result disputes, next steps for unsuccessful candidates, ODE opportunities following the main examination, and pathways to skill-integrated academic progression. Officials clarified that CBOSE continues to maintain transparent rechecking and retotalling services through the digital portal, ensuring that every student has equal access to review mechanisms. They also reminded institutions that extensive counselling support will continue through the academic year to help learners plan their next steps after receiving their results.

The summit concluded with a visionary message from the Chairperson of CBOSE, who emphasized that open schooling is not merely an alternative system—it is a fully evolved educational framework designed to empower learners at every stage of life. He affirmed that the advancements introduced in 2025, particularly in digital credentialing and evaluation governance, place CBOSE among the most forward-looking education bodies in the country. He congratulated all learners for their perseverance and reminded them that their success is a testament to the idea that education must adapt to people's lives—not the other way around.
