SUBJECT: ROLLOUT OF NEW STUDENT IDENTITY VERIFICATION & BIOMETRIC REGISTRATION SYSTEM (2024)

The Central Board of Open Schooling & Examination (CBOSE) officially announces the rollout of the **Student Identity Verification & Biometric Registration System – 2024**, a major advancement in ensuring secure candidate authentication for examinations, admissions, and certification processes.

The open schooling system serves a diverse range of learners, and accurate identity verification has become essential due to increasing incidents of impersonation, fraudulent admissions, forged documents, and misused identity credentials. To safeguard the integrity of the Board's examination processes, biometric verification will now be mandatory for all new admissions and candidates appearing in the 2024–25 examination cycle.

Under the new system, students will undergo biometric registration at designated centres where their fingerprint data, photograph, digital signature, and Aadhaar-linked verification will be recorded. This biometric profile will remain securely stored in the Board's encrypted database and will be used during exam hall entry, assignment submission verification, migration certificate issuance, and result authentication.

Exam centres will be equipped with biometric scanners to ensure that only genuine candidates appear for examinations. This system also prevents multiple enrolment attempts and ensures that each academic record is linked to a single verified identity.

Institutions must facilitate biometric registration for all active learners and provide the necessary support for candidates in remote locations or with limited digital access. Special arrangements will be made for differently-abled students who may require alternative verification methods.

The biometric system enhances transparency, authenticity, and trust in the open schooling system and ensures equal protection for all genuine learners.
