SUBJECT: SPECIAL ACADEMIC REHABILITATION SCHEME (SARS-2025)

CBOSE introduces the **Special Academic Rehabilitation Scheme (SARS-2025)** for learners who have failed multiple attempts in board examinations or those who were unable to complete assignments, practicals, or exam cycles due to personal, medical, or financial difficulties.

SARS-2025 provides an academic recovery route including extended assignment windows, remedial learning modules, personalized mentorship, mock-test systems, and special ODE support. The goal is to ensure that repeated failures do not permanently discourage learners from pursuing secondary or senior secondary education.

Institutions must identify such candidates and enroll them into rehabilitation plans. CBOSE will monitor their progress through periodic evaluations.

This initiative reflects the Board's commitment to inclusive and compassionate education.
